Here is some information about how the funds are administered.

What is U-HELP?

The Ukrainian Humanitarian Educational and Leadership Program (U-HELP) was set up in 2014 by the Australian Federation of Ukrainian Organisations as a means for Australians to securely donate much-needed funds to Ukraine.

Who administers the funds?

In Australia, funds are administered by the board of the AFUO and transferred to an organisation in Ukraine called Patriot Defence. For more information on Patriot Defence visit **patriotdefence.org/en**

What are the funds used for?

- funding first aid training for Ukrainian service personnel and providing them with the appropriate medical and related equipment;
- training medical professionals to treat combat-related injuries, and;
- providing assistance to the families of those who perished during the Maidan movement, such as the Heavenly Hundred.
- a high-level bilateral relations conference in both Kyiv and Australia;
- trade delegations;
- leadership development and training, and;
- information provision in coordination with the Government of Ukraine.

Where can I view financial reports for U-HELP?

Regular reports will be publicly provided by the Board of the AFUO on all funds raised and their expenditure.
